- 2-3 1 to 1 ½-inch 3-ring binders (1 History, 1 English, 1 Grade 8 Logic/Debate)\*
- 4 1-inch 3-ring binders (1 Bible, 1 Science, 1 Science Project, 1 Latin\*
- large binder to store papers at home
- 6 packages of college-ruled notebook paper
- 24+ subject dividers (4 dividers for History, 3 Latin, 4 Science, 4 Science Project, 5 English, 2 Debate, 2 Bible)
